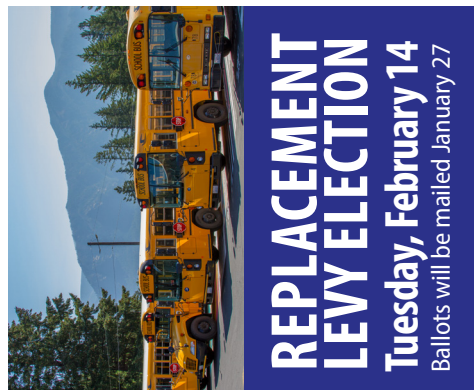

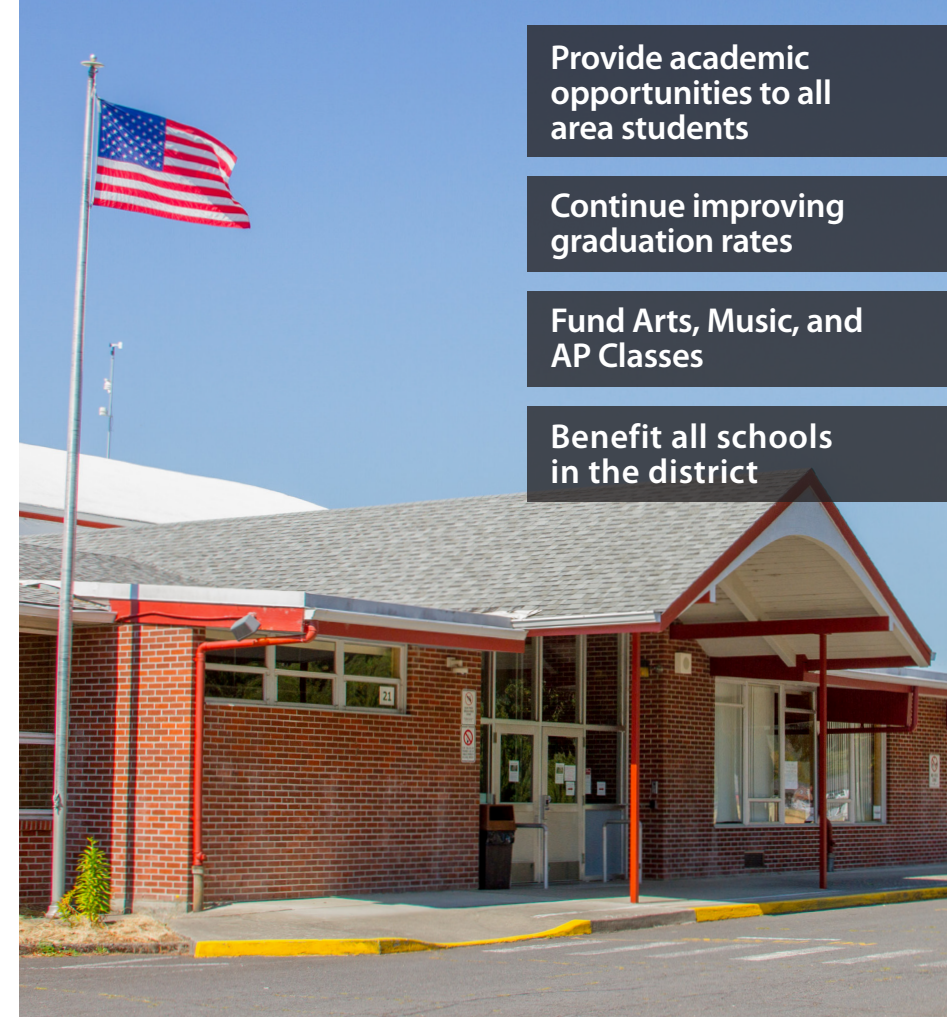

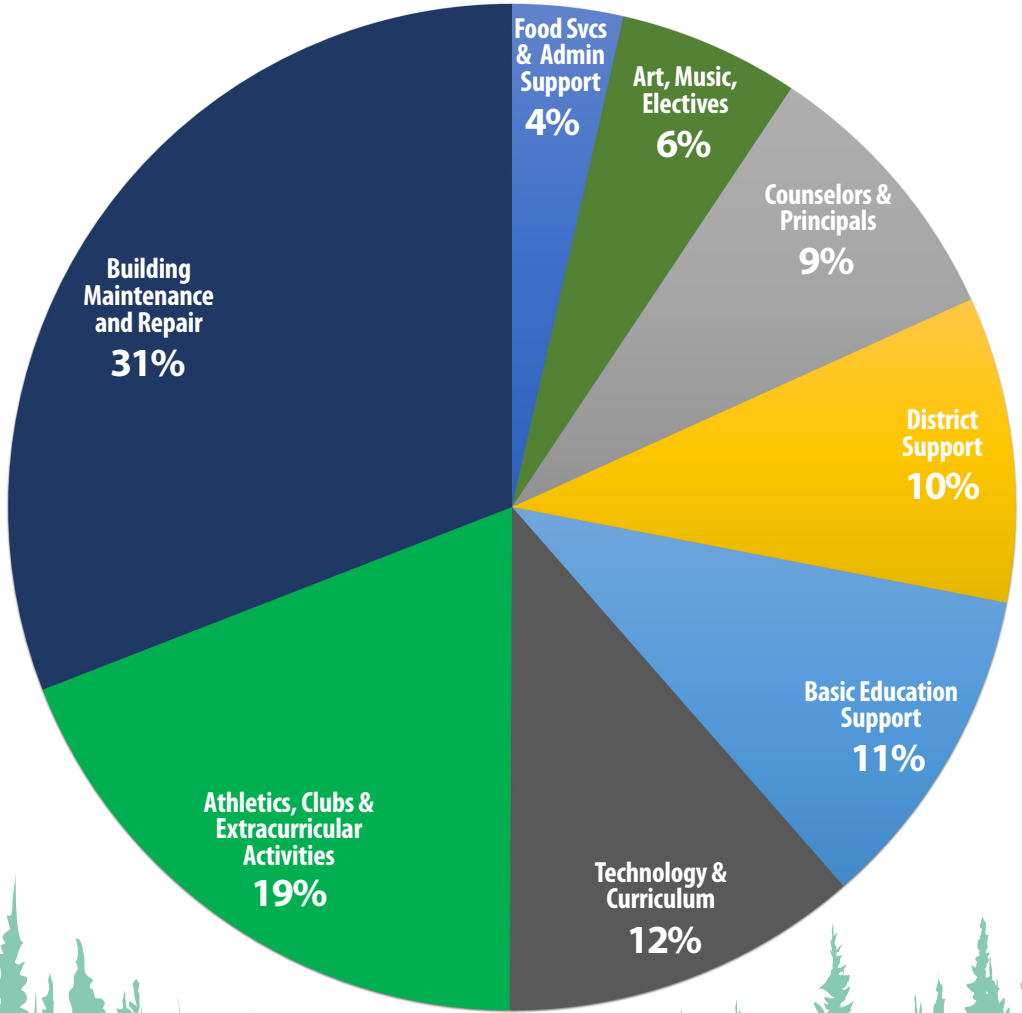


The levy helps fund school programs including **athletics, art, music & electives.**

## DID YOU KNOW?

The ongoing support from Stevenson-Carson's taxpayers through the educational levy helps fund nearly every aspect of the high-quality educational experience the district's students receive.

Without levy support, these programs may be cut or eliminated beginning in 2023-24.



## This levy is **NOT** a new tax.

The district is asking voters to replace the existing levy that expires in 2023 with a three-year levy at a lesser tax rate than voters are currently paying.

### Proposed Levy Amounts & Rates

Year	Estimated Levy Rate*	Levy Amount
This Year (2023)	\$2.01	\$2,300,000
2024	\$1.83	\$2,410,000
2025	\$1.78	\$2,530,000
2026	\$1.68	\$2,660,000

\*Tax rates are per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Future tax rates are estimates.

**TAX EXEMPTIONS:** Disabled persons, veterans with service-connected disabilities, and those 60 years of age or older may be eligible for tax relief. Applications are available at the Skamania County Assessor's office (509) 427-3720.
